Skype: video conference and connect and collaborate with anyone in the world who also has access to skype.

Air sketch Free: described as a visual thinking tool it can connect with any other device and share with any other device on your network

Bodily/Kinesthetic: communicate well through their body and can be taught best through hands on learning and role playing

Storyrobe: create digital stories with pictures and narration to share over the internet; can be combined with the stories of others to create storythreads.
